The termite risk management installed to your home requires annual inspections to be carried out as part of a termite management measure (as per 3660.1). Our annual warranty program allows you to have peace of mind knowing your property will be inspected annually.

For an annual Termite Warranty to be effective the inspections must be continuous. With millions of dollars' worth of termite damage being caused annually, it is a risk that cannot be ignored. It is a greater risk to your home than fire, storms, floods and earthquakes - and insurance companies will not insure against termite attack.

The comprehensive Termicide warranty covers complete reinstatement of structural timber and ancillary timbers damaged by termites at your property, subject to the warranty terms and conditions included in this information package.

Once your inspection is completed you will receive a written report, this will advise you of any conducive conditions or areas of concern relating to foraging termite activity and general knowledge of the termite management measure used on your property along with maintenance tips to limit the risk of termite attack.

To <u>continue</u> your Termicide Warranty, a warranty inspection must be carried out every 12 months and any necessary recommendations reported must be adhered to. The first inspection is due 12 months from the date of installation of the termite management system.

CHEMICAL TERMITE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM WARRANTY

Australian Standard 3660.1:2014 states in it's foreword:-

"The Chemical Termite Management System provided relies on a combination of partial measures to termite passage combined with perimeter inspection zones so that when termites attack, evidence of their workings is in the open where it may be detected more readily during regular inspections"

THE CHEMICAL TERMITE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

- Termicide Chemical Management Systems are installed by trenching the soil areas around the perimeter
 of the home to the concrete footing or adjacent to concrete slab edge and approximately 150mm wide.
 The TermX Replenishment System is installed and encased in a sandy loam and treated with an approved
 termiticide.
- Termicide Chemical Management Systems must only be inspected by Termicide accredited inspectors.
- Termicide Chemical Management Systems must be replenished as required by Termicide Pest Control.
- Termicide Chemical Management Systems sole purpose is to deter and impede foraging termite activity into a building.

NOTES ON SPECIFIC WARRANTIES

Limitations

Both the Product and Installer warranties described hereunder will be voided if the system is breached or contaminated by: -

- a) Repairs, alterations, renovations or other activities immediately adjoining the building.
- a) Land movement that affects the foundations of the building.
- b) Complete or partial penetration by tree roots or other vegetation.
- c) Garden mulch or similar being introduced to chemically treated areas.
- d) Any natural occurrence including but not limited to fire, flood or storm, which might violate the integrity of the barrier.
- e) Any works undertaken by third parties impeding the integrity of the Termicide Chemical Termite Management System as installed.
- f) Failure to act on Recommendations given by Termicide Pest Control.
- g) Failure to replenish the chemical component of the system as required by Termicide Pest Control.
- h) Warranty inspections NOT undertaken by a Termicide accredited inspector.
- i) The Owner/s failure to provide true and correct information to Termicide Pest Control, or any instance wherein the Owner participates in misleading, deceptive or fraudulent conduct in connection with this Warranty.

WARRANTY COVER

Chemical Management System

1. The Termicide Chemical Management System covers complete reinstatement of structural timber members of the building, together with timber skirting boards, timber flooring, timber doors and windows, timber weatherboard cladding and materials removed to gain access to the damaged area.

1. The warranty only covers installations by accredited Termicide installers.

INSTALLATION

The installer warrants to the owner that:-

- 1. Only approved products have been used in the system.
- 1. Installation has been carried out by Termicide Pest Control accredited installers.
- 2. Installation has been carried out in accordance with the Termicide Installation Manual Version 411/2016.
- 3. The complete installation work is to best industry practice.

If a claim is made under this warranty and termite damage is the result of the installer's workmanship, the products will be made good at the installer's cost.

CONDITIONS OF WARRANTY

- 1. The Warrantor agrees and acknowledges that the Owner is entitled to all rights and remedies in respect of the products and services which the Owner has under the *Trade Practices Act* and similar State and Territory laws which cannot be lawfully excluded, restricted or modified. This warranty does not purport to and does not have the effect of excluding, restricting or modifying the exercise of any such right or remedy or the liability of the Warrantor in respect of any such right or remedy.
- 1. The Owner has no other rights or remedies in respect of products or services other than those rights or remedies expressed in this warranty document.
- 2. All other warranties, guarantees and conditions not referred to in this warranty document are excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 3. The Owner of the building must ensure that the warranty inspection is carried out by a licensed and accredited Termicide inspector not exceeding twelve month intervals. Termicide acknowledges the first year of the warranty from the date of installation.
- 4. The Owner acknowledges that the warranty is conditional upon a Termicide treatment certificate being issued by the installer to the Owner at time of installation.
- 5. The Owner agrees to inform Termicide immediately when damage or termite activity is discovered. Failure to contact Termicide immediately will result in the warranty becoming void.
- 6. The Owner agrees to inform future owners of the property of the existence of this warranty and its inclusions and conditions.
- 7. The Owner under the warranty is limited to any one of the following conditions as determined by the Warrantor at its sole discretion.

For Services Provided:-

- 1. To supply the service again.
- 1. Payment to supply the service again.

OTHER EXCLUSIONS

Together with all above occurrences that may void the warranty, the Termicide Chemical Termite Management System warranty does not cover:-

- 1. Damage to furniture, fittings, carpet and clothing.
- 1. Termite entry other than demonstrably through the Termicide Chemical Termite Management System.
- 2. Damage to the Termicide Chemical Termite Management System by third parties.
- 3. Cost of temporary accommodation.
- 4. Economic losses such as loss of rent etc.
- 5. Consequential loss or damage.
- 6. Failure by third parties to comply with warranty conditions.
- 7. Allowing rubbish, timber or mulch material to intervene with the termite barrier and visual inspection zone at ground level.

SUGGESTIONS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF YOUR TERMICIDE CHEMICAL TERMITE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

- 1. Remove garden timbers away from home edge
- 1. Remove any stored timber away from home edge, if possible from property
- 2. Remove gardens & chip bark away from home edge, if possible from property
- 3. Repair any broken or leaky down pipes and/or gutters
- 4. Repair any excessive moisture issues, including drainage
- 5. Extend any overflows away from home edge, including hot water systems and air conditioner units
- 6. Cut overgrown grass to allow for visual inspections of the home edge
- 7. Move stored goods away from home edge
- 8. Cut back any timber gate posts in contact with the home edge and soil
- 9. Move any outdoor fixtures to allow for visual inspection of home edge (eg, BBQ, dog kennel, shed, outdoor furniture etc)
- 10. Ensure attachments to the building such as downpipes and service pipes have a nominal gap (25mm) to allow clear and uninterrupted visual inspection across the visual inspection zone.
- 11. Do not plant vigorous growing trees or shrubs close to your house.
- 12. Do not leave building materials or plant waste leaning against the building.

HOW TO CLAIM ON YOUR WARRANTY (Failure to adhere to the following points will result in the warranty becoming void)

- 1. Contact Termicide directly on (07) 5563 3003, immediately when damage or termite activity is discovered. Failure to contact Termicide immediately will result in the warranty becoming void.
- 1. Do not remove termite tracks or nests.
- 2. Do not attempt to spray or make repairs yourself.

WARRANTY

Subject to all qualifications and conditions stated above, Termicide Pest Control warrants to the Owner for the period of 12 years that the product will remain free from subterranean termite penetration that is a result of defective product.

When a valid claim is established under this warranty Termicide will re-establish the damaged area to a condition consistent to the remainder of the property.
