



Bellaranga Flats have some aesthetic significance as a good example of an Inter-War apartment complex.

Bellaranga Flats are representative of the trend to build apartment blocks in Nedlands in the late Inter-War and Post-War periods

History

The first purpose built flats (Kumara, Smyth Road, and Stirling Court, Stirling Highway) were first listed in the post office directories in 1935. Over the next 6 years another 27 blocks of flats were constructed, and a small number after WWII.
